



NEW YORK STATE WETLANDS FORUM 2017 RESEARCH GRANT PROGRAM

ELIGIBILITY

1. Applicants must be currently enrolled, and enrolled for the spring 2017 semester, as either a matriculated graduate student or junior or senior at a recognized four-year accredited college or university.
2. The candidate must have at least cumulative 3.0 grade point average. Preference will be given to students attending a school within New York State, although this is not a requirement.

ENTRY SUBMITTAL REQUIRMENTS

1. Provide an original article describing your wetland related research. This article must be between 500 and 1,000 words, and should explain the nature, methodology and purpose of the research, as well as how the research pertains to wetland issues relevant to New York State.
2. Provide a NYSWF Research Grant Applicant Evaluation Form completed by a professor from your program of study. See form for additional instructions. Form can be downloaded from www.wetlandsforum.org.
3. Complete the application on page two (which can also be downloaded from www.wetlandsforum.org). Original article, application and evaluation form must postmarked no later than February 15, 2017. Mail to:

There they will be expected to showcase their research and have the opportunity to network with NYSWF members and other environmental professionals from the private, public, and non-profit sectors.
